

White Satin Fabrication

“A hydrochloric-acid based solution is applied to the regular glass, and then rinsed off. This allows for a smooth surface finish, which has excellent properties in terms of durability, wear and stain resistance. Nothing is added to the glass, meaning it will never fade or wear off.”

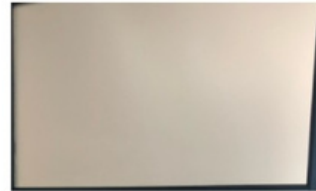
- Standard glass thickness is 1/8”

Oil residue



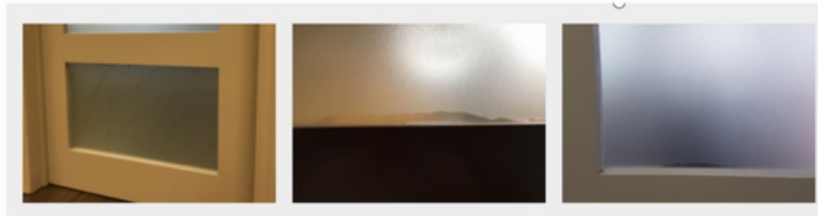

Satin Glass Identifier

On each door with Satin White glass, we apply this orange sticker. It explains the specifications of this glass and cleaning instructions.

Important: Take a look at the very bottom sentence, “Satin White glass appears clear when plastic has not been removed from both sides.” You must peel off the plastic on both sides of the glass to verify.

Pattern Identifier

Each door with a Satin white glass has this stamp on the side where the pattern.
